



What is the Kovner Opportunity Scholarship?

The Kovner Opportunity Scholarship enables talented and ambitious public high school students in Palm Beach and Martin Counties to aspire to and to attend the nation's most challenging and selective 4-year colleges and universities.

High school students apply to this program in the spring of their junior year so that The Kovner Foundation, working in partnership with school guidance counselors, may provide one-on-one counseling and guidance through R&R Education Consultants during the college admissions process. R&R also provides support for Kovner Scholars and monitors their progress through their college years.

The Scholarship provides up to \$10,000 per year for four years towards the cost of full-time attendance at an accredited U.S. college or university for any area of study. Up to ten scholarships will be awarded in 2022.

Who is eligible?

Students currently in their junior year in the partner schools who meet the following criteria may apply:

- Class rank: Top 15%
- Minimum GPA: 3.5 or above
- Financial need
- Citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States

What is the selection criteria?

Selection is a holistic process looking to create a cohort of scholars for whom character, learning and excellence are defining principles. The selection committee will consider each candidate's

- Ambition to succeed at a challenging college or university with preference given to students targeting out-of-state schools
- Scholastic achievement and potential
- Leadership and community service with special notice given to activities that were initiated and run by the student
- Entrepreneurship
- Personal maturity
- Family financial need

Application includes short answer and 2 essay questions

January 28: Initial Application deadline

February 9: Semi-Finalists notified

Application includes 3 essays (250-500 words), 2 teacher recommendations,
1 guidance counselor recommendation, official transcript, parental financial report

March 11: Semi-Finalist application deadline

March 24: Finalists notified

April 21-22: Finalist Interviews

Interviews by selection committee in person (virtual, Zoom)

April 23: Recipients announced
